<b>Hospitality</b>		Help with supplies, setting up, or cleaning up at Ice Cream Social, Fall Pot-Luck, Holiday Performance, and other PTC events.	
<b>Library</b>	On-going	Shelve returned books and organize as needed.	
<b>Teacher Appreciation Luncheon</b>	May date TBD	Help plan the party, collect food donations, assist with childcare, or host, including set-up, service, or clean-up.	
<b>Fall &amp; Spring Workdays</b>	Dates TBD	Help spruce up the playground and our beautiful outdoor areas. Spread mulch, dump sand, rake, or paint. Indoor maintenance and building projects. Childcare provided.	
<b>Classroom Representative</b>	On-going	Send communications about PTC events to your child's class, coordinate teacher gifts, and help teachers with special classroom events.
